DESCRIPTION OF MEDICAL USE

Vulvodynia Compounded Amitriptyline is a topical formulation used to manage vulvodynia by modulating nerve pain and reducing hypersensitivity. As a tricyclic antidepressant, it helps decrease neuropathic pain signals when applied directly to the affected area. This localized delivery minimizes systemic side effects while providing targeted relief.

It works by stabilizing overactive nerve activity, decreasing hypersensitivity in the affected area.
